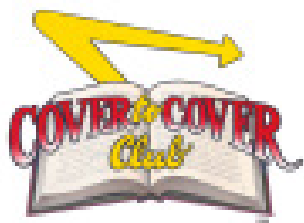

Track & Field

Registration: February 6 - April 10

Season: Season begins April 18. Practices will be twice a

week on Mondays and Wednesdays. Three (3) track meets against other Central Utah recreation track programs. Some travel required to attend meets.

Cost: \$65; includes team shirt, at least 10 practices, and at least 3 track meets.

Ages: 7 years to 14 years old. Age groups follow the United States Track & Field Association (USTFA) age groups which are defined by birth year and not actual age.

Youth Baseball

Registration: February 20 - April 17

Season: Season begins May 24. Games will be played on weeknights and Saturdays. T-Ball & Coach Pitch practices will be determined by the coach as to when and where. Machine Pitch practices will be determined by the coach but will be within specified times the city can supply the pitching machines.

Cost: T-Ball & Coach Pitch \$45, Machine Pitch \$55. Includes team shirt and hat, 8-game season, and participation award.

Ages: T-ball is for Pre-k and Kindergarten ages 4 years old to Kindergarten, must be 4 by the first game. Coach Pitch is for 1st graders, and Machine Pitch is for 2nd graders. School year 2015-16.

Saratoga Springs Police Department Adds New K-9 Rico

The Saratoga Springs Police Department added a new face to the force which has already resulted in multiple narcotic finds and arrests. K-9 Officer Rico, a Belgian Malinois, joined the force in January after being certified by the Utah POST K-9 program for narcotics. Rico is trained in the detection of marijuana, methamphetamine, cocaine, heroin, ecstasy and mushrooms. Rico is replacing the department's previous K-9 Monty who was retired from active service due to health issues.

"We are very appreciative of the support from the National Police Dog Foundation to bring Rico to the Saratoga Springs Police Department," said Officer Derek Dalton,

Rico's handler. "Rico has a great personality and work ethic and will be an asset for Saratoga Springs and Utah County for years to come."

Rico was purchased from Right Hand K-9 in Ogden through a grant from the National Police Dog Foundation. The National Police Dog Foundation (www.nationalpolicedogfoundation.org) is an organization run through public donations that has helped police departments offset the cost of purchasing a K-9 officer since 2004.



Shay Park Fundraiser

Shay Park is nearing completion at the intersection of Aspen Hills Boulevard and Lyndi Lane. The 12-acre park features many amenities including a pavilion, picnic tables, playground equipment, restrooms, playing fields and area for a scale railroad to be installed at a future date.

The Utah Live Steamers Railroad Club is currently raising money for Shay Park to install a 1-inch aluminum rail and locomotives for trains to pull visitors at the park.
