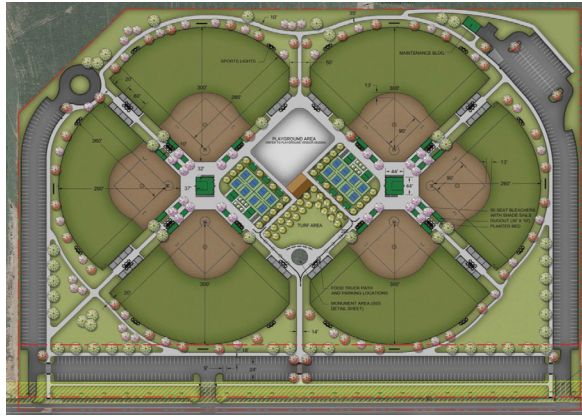

Join Us for the Ground Breaking of Patriot Park

During the October 17, 2017 City Council Meeting, the Council will select a proposal to begin construction of the Patriot Park sports complex. The ground breaking will occur the following day, October 18, 2017 at 6pm. It is anticipated that the park will open in time for 2019 spring sports. The park will include 6 baseball fields, eight pickle ball courts, a military wall, playground, batting cages and concession stands.

Redwood Road Improved Update

Construction is progressing on Redwood Road south of Pioneer Crossing. Once complete, the improvements will reduce delays, increase access, and extend the life of the roadway.

WIDENING: 400 South to Lake View Terrace Road

Extensive utility work is taking place as part of the roadway reconstruction. Newly installed fiber lines will enable UDOT to monitor and adjust the signal timing at Grandview Boulevard remotely. Traffic will be shifted to the west side of Redwood Road by late October or early November while crews reconstruct the east side.

RESURFACING: Village Parkway south, approximately 10 miles

Resurfacing operations continue

south of Village Parkway. Ongoing work includes raising utility manholes, striping, and pavement markings. Construction in this area is expected to be complete by late October. Construction activities and schedule are subject to change.

400 West Project Completed



The 400 West project, located between Aspen Hills Blvd and Crossroads Blvd, is now open for public access. 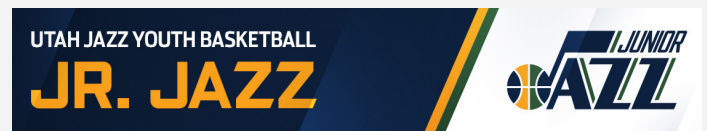
October is Domestic Violence Awareness Month

The Saratoga Springs Police Department Victim Services Program offers free, confidential advocacy support to victims and their families. Domestic violence is the willful intimidation, physical assault, battery, sexual assault, and/or other abusive behavior as a part of a systematic pattern of power and control perpetrated by one intimate partner against another.

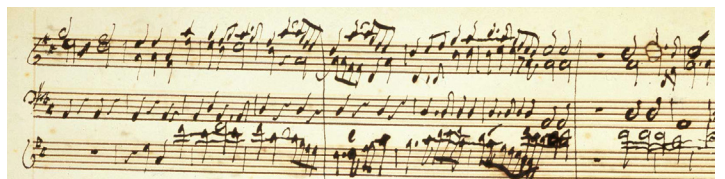
It includes physical violence, sexual violence, psychological violence, and emotional abuse. The frequency and severity of domestic violence can vary dramatically; however, the one constant component of domestic violence is one partner's consistent efforts to maintain power and control over the other. 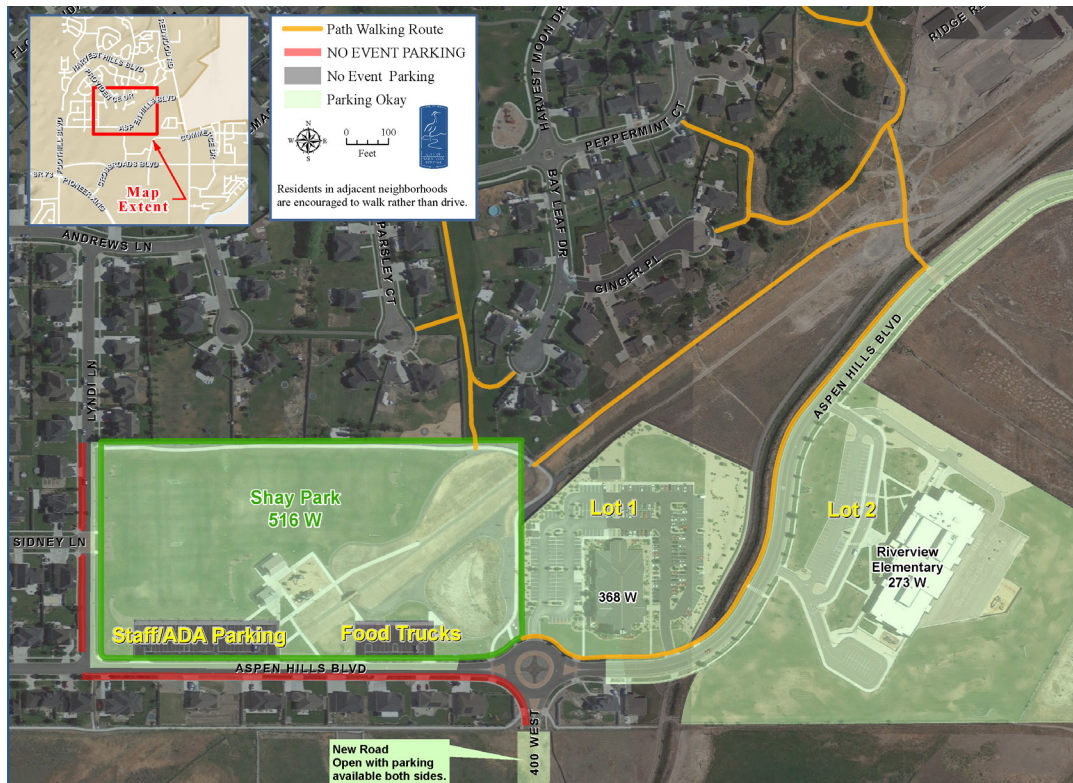
