

Library: Temporary Closure, Feb 24 - Mar 26



The Saratoga Springs Public Library will be closed for flooring repairs from February 24th, 2018 to March 26th, 2018. These repairs are essential for everyone's safety.

We are aware of the inconvenience that this interruption of service will cause, and have taken the following measures to minimize the impact of this closure:

- Items that would fall due during the closure will have a due date of April 2nd, 2018.
- On February 5th, our item limit will temporarily increase to 150 items

- Please do not return Saratoga Springs Public Library items to other libraries.
- Staff will continue to monitor voice mail and respond when able.
- Our website and BookMyne app will continue to function for renewals.
- We will be in the city council chambers from 10 AM to noon on Tuesdays and Thursdays. During this time, a limited selection of items will be available to checkout. We will also run our Music & Movement program at 10:30 AM and our Little Builders

program from 11 AM to noon in the council chambers.

The American Fork, Eagle Mountain, and Lehi libraries have all agreed to provide temporary cards to Saratoga Springs residents free of charge. These cards will be valid from February 26th to April 30th, 2018.

2018 Trash & Recycle Service Schedule

Guidelines for Service:

1. If a holiday (only those shown below on calendar) falls on a weekday, service will be delayed one day following the holiday.
2. Recycle containers that are contaminated with trash in them will NOT be dumped and may be fined.
3. All containers MUST be placed outside at the curb by 7:00 a.m.

4. Containers should be placed in the street with the wheels against the curb or within 2 feet of blacktop with the front of the container facing the street.
5. Containers must be placed 4 feet apart from other containers and 8 feet from mailboxes, poles, fences, trees, or parked vehicles for easy access.
6. Please break-down cardboard boxes.

If you notice any rainbow-like oil sheens on the water draining to a storm inlet, please observe where it may be coming from. A light sheen is understandable, but please report a heavy sheen.
