# Redwood Road Update

Redwood Road  
IMPROVED



## Phase 1

Phase 1 of the Redwood Road improvements south of Pioneer Crossing is nearing completion. The new five-lane configuration from 400 South to Lake View Terrace Road is expected to be open to traffic by mid-June. Crews will continue working after mid-June to complete landscaping and clean up the area.

Remaining work includes the following:

- Microsurfacing (adding a preservation treatment that will extend the life of the new pavement)
- Pavement striping
- Sign installation
- Landscaping
- Trail construction

## Phase 2

Phase 2 construction is expected to begin summer 2018 and includes the following improvements:

- New east-west Continuous Flow Intersection (CFI) at Pioneer Crossing
- Widened road (from three to five lanes between Lake View Terrace Road and Village Parkway)
- New traffic signals at Ring Road and Stillwater Drive
- New trail from Pioneer Crossing to 400 South
- New bike signal at Pony Express Parkway
- Extended bike lanes from 400 South to Village Parkway

Completion of Phase 1 and 2 improvements will reduce delays, increase access and extend the life of the roadway. Construction activities and schedule are subject to change.

# Lakeshore Trail Improvements Open House

Saratoga Springs, in conjunction with the Utah Department of Transportation, is hosting a public open house to discuss the next phase of the Saratoga Springs Utah Lakeshore Trail.

The planned trails will include two, 10-footwide asphalt trails. The first trail segment will connect the existing paved trail along Saratoga Road through the marina, to the existing gravel trail near Saratoga Drive.

The second trail segment will connect to the gravel trail at Eagle Park, and will proceed south to the lift station south of Amanda Lane. Construction for these trail segments are scheduled to begin in 2019.

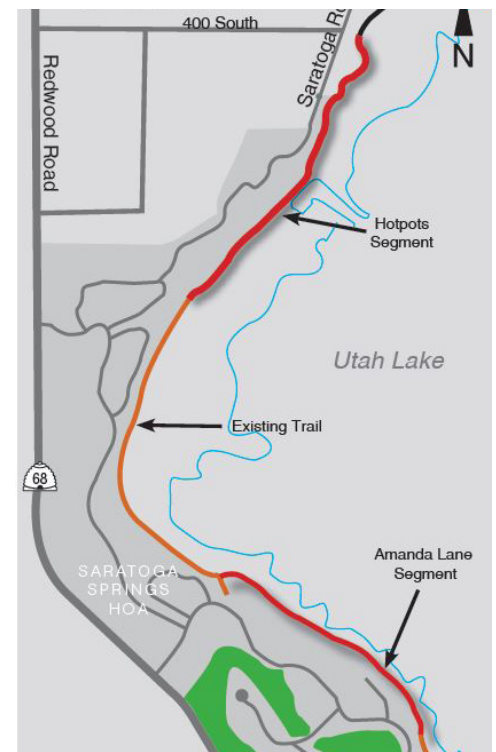
Residents are invited to attend a public open house to discuss the trail improvements. The meeting is scheduled

1. Water brown spots in your lawn with a hose, if you have a second water spicket, instead of increasing the irrigation time on your timer.
2. Place children's water toys on any dry spots in your lawn.
3. Instead of washing your car in the street or driveway, park it on the lawn where it

won't go to waste.

4. Take the pets outside to be bathed—pick a dry spot in the lawn to wash them.
5. Remember that not all brown spots in your lawn are caused from lack of water. If you have distinct irregularly shaped brown spots, the symptoms are most severe in late summer, and section of dead turf can be pulled up easily, the problem is probably grubs, a beetle larva. They feed on your turf's root system and kill it. If you question what is causing your turf problem, contact your USU Extension County Office or a local nursery professional. They will probably want to see a sample of your turf.
