# Phase II: Redwood Road Widening Project

## Pioneer Crossing and Redwood Road Continuous Flow Intersection (CFI)

UDOT is constructing an east-west CFI at the Pioneer Crossing and Redwood Road intersection. Drivers can expect ongoing traffic shifts on Pioneer Crossing near Redwood Road and Riverside Drive intersections until construction slows down at the end of November. ## Redwood Road (Lake View Terrace Road to Village Parkway)

Crews are conducting utility work and road reconstruction on the east and west sides of Redwood Road. Traffic shifts are ongoing to allow space for work.

Traffic shifts, shoulder closures and

turn-lane closures will be ongoing on side streets while crews complete road work, landscaping and utility work.

Construction activities and schedule are subject to change.

## Secondary Water Shut-Off

It's that time of the year again. The City will be winterizing the pressurized irrigation system beginning the week of October 15. After that date, the system will be deactivated until spring. Residents with pressurized irrigation should leave individual shut-off valves in the "open" position to allow for proper drainage of the system.

Each irrigation system must be completely drained to prevent damage to the system components caused by water freezing inside the pipes, sprinklers and valves. After November 1st, please close your individual shut-off valve to the "off" position in preparation for spring. 

## PROGRAM OVERVIEW
