

## Disposing of Unused Prescriptions

Unused or expired prescription medications are a public safety issue, leading to potential accidental poisoning, misuse, and overdose. Proper disposal of unused drugs saves lives and protects the environment. Bring your expired, unused or unwanted medications to the Saratoga Springs' Police Department for safe medication disposal in their permanent drop box.

Here is how NOT to dispose of medications:

Many people aren't aware

of this, but most medications should NOT be poured down the sink, flushed down the toilet, or thrown directly in the trash in their original packaging. Here's why:

- Small amounts of medication can enter the water system when medication is poured down the sink or flushed down the toilet, even after the wastewater is treated.
- Children or pets can find bottles of pills when they are thrown in the trash. They can also be found by thieves who go through trash cans to find pain medication or get your personal information from the bottles.
