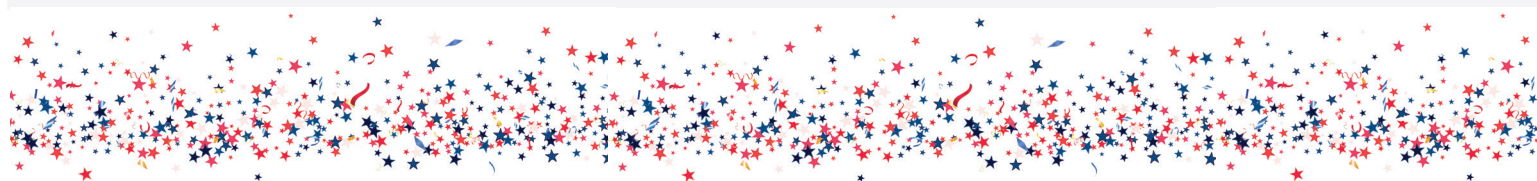

As your Fire Chief, I am implementing an **aerial fireworks restriction** on both sides of the following streets in the City of Saratoga Springs. This is due to extreme fire conditions on the 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th of July 2019; and the 22nd, 23rd, 24th and 25th of July 2019.

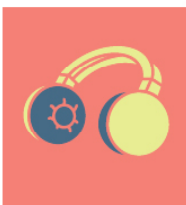

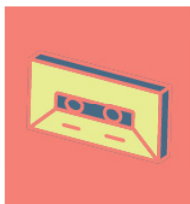

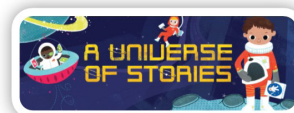

How to Prove Service for the Veterans Monument

Are you wondering how to get the necessary documents to prove service for the veteran you are wanting to honor by purchasing a plaque for the Veterans Memorial? Here are some easy to follow instructions:

First, if you need it for yourself, do one of the following:

1. Go to [MilConnect: https://milconnect.dmdc.osd.mil/milconnect/](https://milconnect.dmdc.osd.mil/milconnect/)

a. If you have an account, log in and go to [DPRIS: https://milconnect.dmdc.osd.mil/milconnect/protected/portlet/dpris](https://milconnect.dmdc.osd.mil/milconnect/protected/portlet/dpris) and fill out the form to request documents from your OMPF.

b. If you do not have an account, you will need to create one first.

2. Mail or fax (314-801-9195) a Standard Form 180 to the National Personnel Records Center (NPRC). <https://www.archives.gov/files/sf180-request-pertaining-to-military-records-exp-april2018-1.pdf>

3. Write a letter to the NPRC.

Second, if you need it for

someone else and you are the next of kin (sibling, parent, child, spouse) of a Veteran who has passed away:

1. Mail or fax a Standard Form 180 to the National Personnel Records Center (NPRC). <https://www.archives.gov/files/sf180-request-pertaining-to-military-records-exp-april2018-1.pdf>

2. Write a letter to the NPRC.

Careful in our Landscaping

When landscaping or beautifying your yard with delivered materials-whether it's bark, sand, decorative rock, gravel, etc. Those materials should never be dumped in any public right-of-way. The public right-of-way includes streets, sidewalks, curbs and gutters.

Materials should always be dumped in your driveway or yard so that storm water does not carry it away and into the City's storm drain inlets. Not doing so can clog the inlets and prevent the storm water from properly draining, which may also cause flooding or overflow on the roads.

As a good reminder when purchasing materials to be delivered to your home, please take the time to prepare an area for the placement of the product. Also, make a plan to use it as quickly as possible so that it does not wash off your driveway and end up the storm drain from rain or other weather.

Finally, please remember that storm water

is not filtered, and that anything that runs down the gutters and streets eventually ends up in our rivers and lakes. Don't Forget, "Only Rain Down The Drain" and please, let's leave it better than we found it.
