- October 6 – Last day to register by mail or through a registration drive.
- October 14 – VOTE BY MAIL
Ballots mailed to all active registered voters. Look for them! The NEW DRIVE-BY City Hall Ballot Drop Box is open beginning October 14 and will close November 5, 2019 at 8pm.
- October 21 - Last day for a new registrant to register in person or online and receive a by-mail ballot.
- October 29 – Last day to register online or in-person.
- November 4 – By mail postmark deadline– If in doubt, place it in a drop

box.

- November 5 – Election Day Service Center at City Hall opens at 7am and closes at 8pm.
- November 6-19 – Canvass Period - final counting of all remaining ballots.



- Check with your school on access to Sora. It is Overdrive for schools and free. Contact your school's library staff for questions about access.
- If your family home schools, you can gain access to your boundary school's library by filling out a form through the Alpine School District.
- Project Gutenberg offers over 59,000 free eBooks. Choose among free epub and Kindle eBooks, download them or read them online. You will find the

world's great literature here, with focus on older works for which U.S. copyright has expired. Thousands of volunteers digitize and diligently proofread the eBooks, for enjoyment and education.

- You also have access to Utah's Online Library <https://onlinelibraryuen.org/login>. The log in information is available through your school's library staff, or here in the library. You can either come in or call, and we will be happy to share it. This resource gives you free access to:

Preparation for Winter

It's that time of year when we start cleaning up the garage to make room for our cars before that first snow storm starts flying.

With that in mind, you may find items such as cleaning detergents, antifreeze, used oils, old gasoline and other fluids or chemicals. If these items have been stored for a while and you're not using them, it may be time to get rid of them properly.

As a reminder, these items should not be dumped down a sink, a toilet, in the curb or down a storm drain as these all lead directly

into our lakes. If you find these items and aren't quite sure what to do with them, please contact anyone within our Public Works Department at (801)-766-6506 and we'll be happy to help with proper disposal.

You may also visit the Utah County Health Department's website at www.utahcountyonline.org/dept/Health/hhw/.

Please remember, "Only Rain Down the Drain" and let's leave it better than we found it.

Secondary Water Shut Off

The Public Works Department will begin winterizing the Pressurized Irrigation system around October 15th. After that date, the system will be deactivated until spring.

Please leave your individual shut-off valves in the "open" position to allow for proper drainage of the system. Each irrigation system must be completely drained to prevent damage to the system

components caused by water freezing inside the pipes, sprinklers, and valves.

After November 1st please close your individual shut-off ball valve to the "off" position (this is typically perpendicular to the pipe) in preparation for spring.
