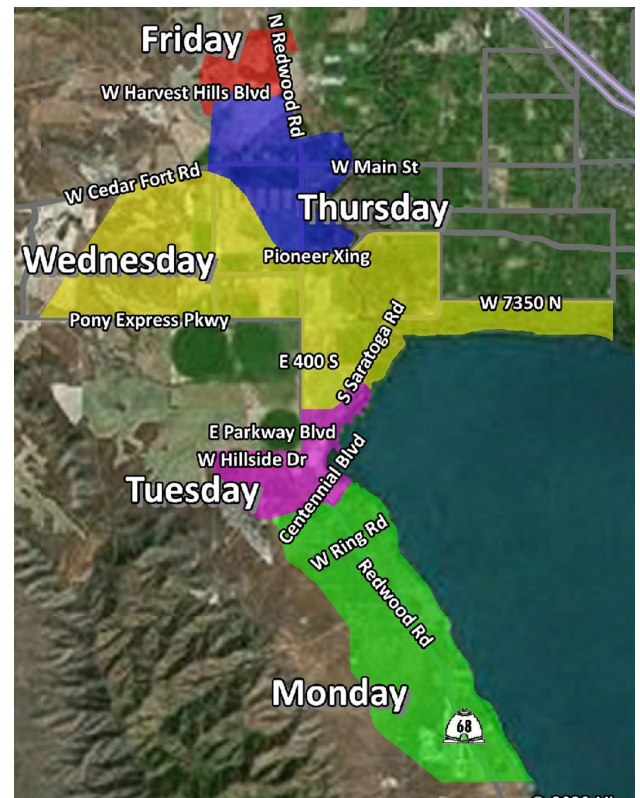

## Garbage & Recycling Service Changes

Curbside recycling and waste collection days are changing in some areas of the city starting FEBRUARY 15, 2021. Here are some of the changes that you can expect.

The city will now be divided into five pick up zones. Each zone will have a different day of service. Some of the zones have streets as the dividing line. If you are on a street that is a dividing line, your pick up could be on a separate day from those across the street from you. You can access an interactive map on the city website to verify which zone your home resides in, by typing your address into the search bar on the map.

Although recycling will still be picked up every other week, garbage and recycling will now be picked up on the same day of service. For your convenience we have included a new

## GUIDELINES TO ENSURE CONSISTENT SERVICE

- If a holiday (only those shown above on calendar) falls on a weekday, service will be delayed one day following the holiday.
- Recycle containers that are contaminated with trash in them will **NOT** be dumped.
- All containers **MUST** be placed outside at the curb by **7:00 a.m.**
- Containers should be placed in the street with the wheels against the curb or within **2 feet** of blacktop with the front of the container facing the street
- Containers must be placed **4 feet** apart from other containers and **8 feet** from mailboxes, poles, fences, trees, or parked vehicles for easy access.
- Please **break-down** cardboard boxes

Under city code 13.08.08 vehicles parked on the street must be currently registered with current registration decals displayed on the rear plate. Fri-Sat: 10:00 am - 5:30 pm

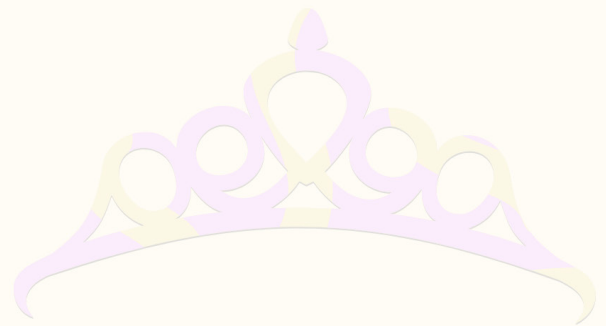
As a reminder the library is still open for you to come inside during our regular hours

# The Right Way to Clear Snow Off Your Walkways

Saratoga Springs continues to welcome new residents from all over. Some are seeing snow for the first time in their lives and have reached out to our offices asking what is the proper way of removing snow from their sidewalks, driveways and walkways.

When shoveling or using a snow blower remember all snow must be directed & kept on your own property. The snow cannot be pushed, shoveled or blown into the city roadways or neighboring properties and must stay within your property boundaries. Also, please remember to use as little salt or de-icer as possible to prevent any additional contaminated runoff.

Keep in mind that we have miles of roadways to clear quickly to keep residents as safe as possible and we are again reminding everyone to please remove vehicles, basketball stands, garbage/recycling cans and any other items from the street during a storm as soon as possible so we can do our jobs safely and in a timely manner. As you can imagine, it's very frustrating for snow plow crews to effectively clean your streets when they are not clear. Please help us help you!

Always remember "Only Rain Down The Drain" and "Let's Leave It Better Than The Way We Found It" and "We all live downstream."

## SHOVELING YOUR WALKS, DRIVES & MORE

- Property owners are responsible for keeping all sidewalks along their property free of snow and ice.
- It is important to keep the area around fire hydrants free of snow.
  - it is the home owners' responsibility to clear snow from around fire hydrants in front of their home.
- State law prohibits residents from depositing snow onto city streets.
  - Snow removed from driveways and sidewalks should be shoveled onto lawns or park strip areas and not onto public streets.
