Spring Cleaning the Garage/Shed

As the weather warms up and spring cleaning begins, let's focus on ways we can eliminate storm water pollution. As you

begin your spring cleanup remember that automobile fluids, paints, old batteries, pesticides, and other household chemicals should not be thrown away with the rest of your garbage.

If taken to the landfill, these substances can leach into our groundwater. And, if left out or dumped into streets, storm drains or drainages, they can make their way to our waterways and into Utah Lake. This is both harmful to people and the environment. Only storm water should go into storm drains!

If you have any Household

Hazardous Waste that you need to dispose of, you can ALWAYS dispose of household hazardous materials at either county waste station! Many items are FREE disposal, such as paint, oil, gasoline, pesticides, and cleaners. Electronics, trash and some other items may have a small fee.

Medications can be brought to most police departments and pharmacies for disposal. For more information please visit the Utah County Health Departments Website at www.health.utahcounty.gov/hhw.
