Join Us For Our Silver Jubilee

Saratoga Splash Days is bigger and better than ever with our city's Silver Jubilee celebration June 8-11! There is something fun for everyone! See the full schedule at www.saratogaspringscity.com/splashdays.

The City of Fun Carnival will run Wednesday, June 8, through Saturday, June 11, at Neptune Park. Wednesday night is Family Night. Pre-sale wristband sales run through June 8 on the city website.

The Family Picnic in the Park on Thursday, June 9, will include giant games provided by Communities That Care at 6 PM, a magic show featuring amazing local magician Scott Chamberlain at 7 PM, and a family dance party with Bronco Entertainment at 8 PM.

Be sure to bring your chairs and blankets and stick around to watch Disney's "The Jungle Cruise" on the big screen. The movie will start around 9:15 PM. Food trucks will be at the park from 5 - 9 PM.

Friday will feature the Splash Bash at Sunrise Park from 3 - 5 PM. This year, we will have a drought-friendly party with extra inflatables, games, treat trucks and more. An area will be designated for toddlers and small kids separate from the activities for older kids.

We encourage parents to pick up a free safety wristband at the City Information Booth for each of their children participating in the event in case you become separated from your kids. These will be available at all events and are part of our safety

plan. We want families to have a fun, safe experience.

Friday Fun moves to Neptune Park for the evening. The Splash Boutique will be open from 4 - 9 PM and feature local crafters, small businesses and other shopping opportunities. Food trucks will be open from 5 - 9 PM. At 8 PM, get up and dance with The Groove

Merchants at our giant concert followed by a light show. This concert is always a good time!

We are excited to have our traditional Grand Parade on the morning of Saturday, June 11 at 10 AM. The parade will run along Foothill Drive (800 West) to 400 North, then to Thunder Boulevard. Find your spot and cheer for local teams, bands, royalty, classic cars, princesses and super heroes, and more.

Enjoy the day at Neptune Park following the parade. The boutique will be open from noon to 4 PM. Live entertainment will start on the stage at noon and

feature local performers. The Flashback Brothers will provide a concert at 2 PM. View the car show and vote for your favorites, grab lunch from the food trucks, and enjoy the afternoon's activities.

If pickleball is your thing, sign up for the Pickleball Tournament that will be taking place at Patriot Park from 5 - 9 PM Saturday evening.

In celebration of our city's 25th anniversary, we will have an extra special fireworks show this year. Beginning at about 9:30 PM, the fireworks will be launched near Patriot Park but will be visible from all over the city as well as on the lake. If you are at Neptune Park for the carnival, you will still have a great view of the fireworks show!

Keeping Disposed Water Clear of Chemicals

As temperatures in Utah start warming up, more and more residents consider cooling off by installing pools and spas in their yards. Maintenance on pools and spas require many chemicals to keep them clean and safe for

your family.

There will be times when you need to drain water for cleaning or maintenance during the summer months, and it's important to consider where that large amount of water will go when draining. It is your responsibility to control runoff without it traveling onto anyone else's property.

Before you drain your water, it's important to make sure it is dechlorinated. This is done by first uncovering the spa or pool and letting direct sun light hit on the water (two weeks minimum).

This step can usually dissipate all of the chlorine in pool/spa water effectively. After the two weeks have passed, test the water and

make sure all of the chlorine is out (you may need to add a dechlorinating liquid to remove all levels of chlorine).

After the water has been dechlorinated, you are legally able to drain it into our city's storm water system, which lies in the curb/gutter. If you didn't spend the time to do it right, you could be sending toxic water to our fresh water lakes and streams, which can cause harm to our aquatic life.

If you are caught illegally dumping chemically treated water in the storm drain system, it could result in a fine from the Storm Water Division - which can be a costly lesson. Always remember "We all live downstream" & "Let's Leave It Better Than We Found It".

Keeping Our Dogs Safe

As the weather warms up, we would like to remind everyone to not leave pets unattended in vehicles. Cracking windows or parking in shady spots has almost no effect on the temperature inside a vehicle, which on average is 30 degrees greater than the outside temperature. Dogs can begin to suffer heat stroke around 88 degrees. Officers enforce this code under code 9.01.20 Cruelty to Animals.
