

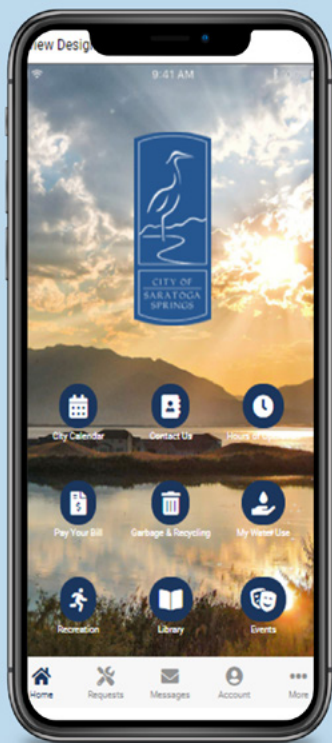

Fee Rate Increase

In 2022 the city conducted a utility rate study to determine if the City's utility rates were sufficient to meet the current and future service and delivery infrastructure needs. The study showed that a rate increase was needed for specific utilities to continue to provide service. The following adjusted rates will go into effect January 2023.

Street lights will increase \$0.67 from \$2.83 a month to \$3.50 a month.

Irrigation water rates will increase for irrigation use that enters the top three tiers of the usage allotment. That is, for users that use 150% above the allotment for the property. This amount of usage must be subsidized with culinary water. These fees reflect the additional cost of that use. Saratoga Springs is a member of the

North Pointe Solid Waste Special Service District. North Pointe Solid Waste is raising their waste disposal fees due to multiple factors including a new transportation contract and inflation. A new garbage rate will go into effect January 2023 to meet the additional cost. Rate for the first garbage can and each additional garbage can will increase \$0.10 from \$15.15 to \$15.25.

SHOVELING YOUR WALKS, DRIVES & MORE



- Property owners are responsible for keeping all sidewalks along their property free of snow and ice.
- It is important to keep the area around fire hydrants free of snow.
 - it is the home owners' responsibility to clear snow from around fire hydrants in front of their home.
- State law prohibits residents from depositing snow onto city streets.
 - Snow removed from driveways and sidewalks should be shoveled onto lawns or park strip areas and not onto public streets.

Making The Most Of Infiltration

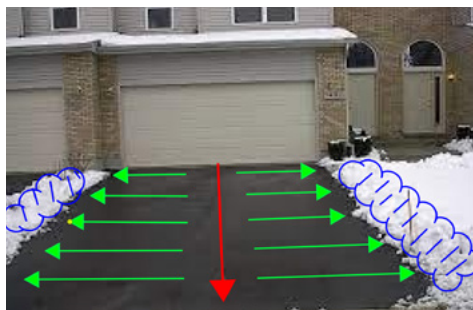

Utah is known for the greatest snow on the earth and we are grateful to continue to receive so much of it! We want to thank our residents for assisting in snow removal in and around your neighborhoods. We encourage our residents to be mindful of the following issues during the remainder of this winter and the coming spring months.

When clearing your driveway, take care not to shovel snow from your property out into city streets, as debris and left-over salts can collect in gutters and storm drain systems.

Shoveling snow onto grassy areas

helps recharge ground water, filters



pollutants in the snow melt, and prevents snow from being pushed back into your driveway.

This year some of us are still dealing with fallen leaves, please help by removing

these and other debris in and around your gutters to prevent water building up.
