If a **red** holiday falls on a weekday, collection will be delayed by one day following the holiday. Collection day will be based on map. See city website for trash collection map. Recycle carts that are contaminated will **NOT** be dumped. All carts **MUST** be placed at the curb by **7 am**. Carts should be placed in the street with the wheels against the curb or within **2 feet** of blacktop with the front of the cart facing the street. Carts must be placed **4 feet** apart from other carts and **8 feet** from mailboxes, poles, fences, trees, or parked vehicles. Please flatten cardboard.

Often, as we are cleaning up our holiday decorations and throwing out those dried out Christmas trees we begin to look at decluttering and de-junking the house. Live tree disposal is available at the south fire station until January 10. Make sure to remove all lights and decorations before disposing of your tree.

When throwing away or recycling old clutter, here are a few things to remember when it comes to garbage and recycling

services. Make sure that you are only putting appropriate items in the recycling can. Items such as collapsed cardboard, plastic bottles or tin and aluminum cans. Additional costs may apply if a recycle truckload is contaminated with unacceptable items. Additional information on accepted recyclable items can be found on the city website.

Place cans at the curb no later than 7 AM on service days. See the Garbage

If you are waiting for a garbage can(s) to be delivered, call Republic Services at 801-785-5935 before your scheduled service day to arrange removal of garbage bags. Winter De-Icing

Using rock salt has always been a good method for melting ice in the winter time. Some homeowners like to use ice

melt, sand or kitty litter. Some have even proposed using alfalfa meal, cracked corn, and even old discarded coffee grounds.

As friendly reminder, all these materials can have a negative impact on the environment when introduced into our waterways. Snow and ice tends to collect all sorts of debris in the winter months. When it thaws, we would like to think that all of that debris gets washed away. Unfortunately most of the debris get flushed right into wetlands and the water ways with little to no treatment. One

of the best options in dealing with snow and ice is to shovel early and shovel often.

The City would like to thank everyone that is looking out for our waterways. Whatever snow and ice removal method you use this season, please be mindful of the potential impacts it can have on the waters we love.
