

Details

- Registration opens 14 days before an event (with some exceptions).
- Registration closes 1 hour before the event starts (or when full).
- There is a waitlist option available if registration is full. You will be notified by email if you are accepted off of the wait list.
- If registration is not open you will see text stating “Registration is now closed”.



When registering you will be required to input your library card number (without spaces) and your PIN. If you do not have this information, you can reset it online by visiting our website, accessing the catalog and selecting the “Reset My Password/Pin” link. An email will be sent to you to reset the password.

Fill out any information requested and you will receive an email confirming your registration. You will be able to manage your registration online through the website.

NEW CONTENT CONTROL FEATURE ON LIBBY!

To enable this feature, click the middle button on the bottom taskbar. Under settings click on content control.



By default Libby for Everyone is turned on. To make it Libby for kids click on the kid on the left of the slider. This will only show titles for kids (0-12) and young adults (13-18). Additionally you can uncheck the boxes that allow young adult content.

Early literacy at home

LITERACY ISN'T JUST READING!



What is letter awareness, and why is it important ?

Knowing that letters are different from each other, knowing letter names and sounds, and recognizing letters everywhere are the basics of letter awareness.

To read words, children have to understand that a word is made up of individual letters.

What Can You Do to Help Build This Skill?

- Look at and talk about different shapes (*letters are based on shapes*)
 - Play “same and different”-type games
 - Look at “I Spy” type books
 - Notice different types of letters (“a” vs “A”) on signs and in books
 - Read ABC books
 - Talk about and draw the letters of a child’s own name

S.T.E.A.M AT HOME

Density Rainbow Experiment

Step 1: Pour 1 cup of water into each empty cup

Step 2: Add a couple drops of different colored food coloring to each cup and mix (To make easier, use less colors, 2-6 colors are recommended)

Step 3: Mix different amounts of sugar into each water cup, putting the most amount of sugar in the color you pour first (color on bottom), and the least amount of sugar in the color you will pour last (color on top)

*Step 4: Using the baster, slowly pipe equal amount of the different colors in order from most sugar to least sugar into your container

*This process might take a few tries to make a rainbow, keep experimenting!

What is Density?

Density is the amount of space something takes up in relation to the amount of mass it has. Mass is the amount of matter something has.

Matter is anything that has weight and takes up space.

A Hypothesis is a guess or prediction about something you can test.

After the Experiment

The liquids with different densities will form layers in the container. The most dense liquid (has the most sugar) will be at the bottom.

What's Your Hypothesis?

After Step 3 and before Step 4, hypothesize what will happen when you put the different density liquids in the same container. Will the liquids mix, or not? How did you come to that conclusion?

What You Need:

- 2(or more) cups (1 cup per color)
- Warm Water
- Measuring Cup
- Food Coloring
- Spoon and Baster
- A Type of Container, i.e. Jar, Bottle
