Unlocking your Car: An officer will come unlock your car free of charge if you call and request help at (801) 798-5600



Car Seat Checks: Free car seat checks are offered to residents. Checks take approximately 30 minutes. To schedule a car seat check please call Melissa Hamer at (801) 420-6326

Disposal of unwanted or expired medications: Bring any pills (no liquids or needles) to our office Monday-Thursday 8 am-5 pm and Friday 8 am-noon

Fingerprinting: Wednesday and Thursday 11 am-1:45 pm \$10 resident/\$20 nonresident. Individuals are required to present a valid government issued photo identification at time of fingerprinting. Individuals must make an appointment on our website before coming into our office.

Home Vacation Checks: Our officers conduct free home checks as they are able for residents who will be gone during the holidays or for extended periods of time throughout the year. Fill out a sheet found on our website or pick one up at the Police Department.
