3.2 Mile Extension of The Mountain View Corridor

Saratoga Springs, UT, September 13, 2023

Saratoga Springs completes additional north/south corridor. The Mountain View Corridor Extension project extends the Mountain View Corridor from Pony Express Parkway approximately 3.2 miles south to Lariat Boulevard. This will provide an alternative route to Redwood Road, alleviating traffic congestion, enhancing accessibility, and create a smoother driving experience for residents and commuters.

Funding for this project began in 2019 when the City successfully secured almost \$10M in Utah County funds through TIP funding program, however, this money was not available until 2024 and only covered about half of the anticipated project cost with the City's development fees covering the remainder. Understanding the urgent need for the project, the City entered into an advanced funding agreement with the County and partnered with Brixton Park development group to expedite construction of the roadway. The project cost about \$26.5M with construction costs comprising \$20M, design and construction management totaling \$2M, and ROW acquisition costs of about \$4.5M.

Work began in the summer of 2022 and was completed by Red Pine Construction who did an outstanding job meeting both all project deadlines and dealing with one of the wettest winter and springs in recent record. This is one of the largest road projects ever undertaken by the City and would not have been possible without the support and assistance from MAG and Utah County who assisted in securing TIP funding, from SITLA and the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints for working with the City on ROW for the roadway and construction access between Pony Express Parkway and Grandview Boulevard, and the Jacob and Stoddard families for working with the City on securing ROW and access between Grandview Boulevard and Lariat Boulevard.
