Saratoga Springs Will Hold Groundbreaking for New City Hall/Library Facility

Saratoga Springs, UT, March 13, 2024 – Saratoga Springs will hold a groundbreaking ceremony on Monday, March 18, 2024, for a new City Hall and Library facility. The groundbreaking will be held at 4:00 PM followed by a Touch a Truck event and a special Community Helper Story Time at 4:30 PM. The ceremony will take place just north of the Public Safety Building located at 367 S Saratoga Road.

The new facility will be the next phase of the Saratoga Springs Municipal Campus located east of the existing Patriot Park. The City Council is looking to the future of Saratoga Springs by building a facility that plans for additional growth. The four-story City Hall will provide needed office space for City staff along with a larger Council Chambers for public meetings and additional community multi-space areas.

The new library will hold four times the collection size of the current library. It will have a dedicated programming space, study rooms, study nooks, a business center, and additional seating for casual reading. The facility will include a drive-up book drop along with an indoor book drop.

Residents told us they wanted a City Hall and Library that had a connection to nature. The facility will be built with windows and skylights allowing for natural light and bringing the beautiful views of the area into the building. The building will be positioned to take advantage of the views of Mount Timpanogos and Utah Lake.
