### Message From Mayor Jim Miller



2024 has ushered in significant progress for Saratoga Springs. In March we began construction of the new City Hall and Library. The new facility will increase the size of the current library by four times and provide space to serve our residents better. The new City Hall and Library was built with a look to the future. Until needed by the city, the second floor will be leased to Utah County, giving them space to provide services in our community.

The council and I have been working with local legislatures, UDOT, and MAG to obtain additional funding for regional roads in our area. UDOT announced transportation projects totaling 2.4 billion dollars for northwest Utah County. This work will connect MVC in Utah County to Salt Lake County, finishing the inner freeway from I15 in Lehi to Pioneer Crossing, and extending a freeway towards Eagle Mountain. In addition to widening Pioneer Crossing to allow for flex lanes during peak commuter traffic times.

This coming year we will extend Pony Express Parkway to the east, widening the road to three lanes and widening Saratoga Road from Pioneer Crossing to Pony Express Parkway. Mountain View Corridor from Pioneer Crossing to Pony Express Parkway will be widened to five lanes. This will offer additional lanes to help traffic move through these areas more efficiently during peak traffic times. As part of the South Mountain View Corridor project, we will realign 400 N and Evans Lane. This realignment is needed to place a traffic signal at that intersection. As one of the fastest-growing cities in Utah, we have experienced growing pains. Through our efforts, we have helped the state see the need for funding regional roads in our area. Providing for better traffic movement, especially during peak traffic times.

## Looking To The Future

### CITY ROAD PROJECTS

- **Widening Mountain View Corridor from Pioneer Crossing to Pony Express Parkway to five lanes: anticipated start spring of 2025 with completion by late Fall 2025.**
- **Widening Pony Express Parkway to three lanes from Saratoga Rd to 1100 W: anticipated start spring of 2025 with completion late fall 2025.**
- **Expansion and signalization of intersection at Pony Express Pkwy and Saratoga Road along with additional improvements on Saratoga Road from Pony Express Pkwy to Pioneer Crossing: anticipated start end of 2025.**
- **Replacement of Jordan River Bridge on Pony Express Parkway to 5 lanes to facilitate future widening of the roadway: anticipated start in 2027**

- **City Hall & Library : Anticipated Completion at the end of 2025.**
- **Final Phase of South Marina : Opening Summer 2025**
- **Second Phase of North Marina : Anticipated Start Winter 2025**
