Saratoga Springs Residents Serve Together To Honor Those Who Lost Their Lives on 9/11

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE - Saratoga Springs, UT – September 8, 2025 - Saratoga Springs is proud to partner with Alpine School District, JustServe, The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, and other local organizations to offer volunteer opportunities in honor of the 9/11 National Day of Service. Last year, more than 2,000 residents participated in service projects across the city. This year, even more volunteers are expected. The 2025 service opportunities include both projects organized by local groups and ideas submitted by residents.

A wide variety of service projects will be available throughout the day. Some projects can be completed off-site, such as creating blankets for Wyatt's Comfort Bundles, which supports children with cancer; donating to the Vista Heights Middle School Pantry, available to all residents; or contributing to the Birthday Box, which provides birthday kits to underserved children in the community. In-person opportunities include assembling gift baskets for first responders, painting projects at local schools, and participating in park clean-up efforts throughout Saratoga Springs.

Corrine Prestwich, Civic Events Coordinator for Saratoga Springs, said. "As we mark the 24th anniversary of the terrorist attacks on 9/11, we invite our community to join together in a Day of Service in the spirit of unity and remembrance. We honor the memory of those who lost their lives, as well as those who stepped forward to give aid to others. Each act of service, large or small, makes the world a little bit better. It uplifts not only those receiving service, but also those who serve. The thousands of hours of service given on this day have a unifying effect on our community that will continue to ripple outward. If you can't join us in person for one of our projects, we encourage you to find a way to reach out to someone wherever you are. Together, we can honor the past by building a brighter future."
